



Staffing:

- All Tri-State PGA staff that work during an Isaly's Junior Golf Event will be required to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) including face masks and gloves.
- Staff will limit any contact with players during ruling, ball searches, and other interactions.
- Staff will also be responsible for sanitizing any equipment loaned from the tournament van including radios, tents, etc.

Arrival Information:

- All Junior Tour Golfers must register with the Junior Golf App (Blue Golf) No Exceptions will be made
- Players will receive their water bottle tee gifts in a gift area near the practice area. Water Bottles will have your name and tee time on them
- Golfers will be permitted on the property 30 minutes prior to the start of their tee time (7:30 tee time, 7:00 Arrival, Range 7:00-7:15, Putting Green 7:15-7:20, 7:20 Tee Staging Area for announcements, Tee Time 7:30 AM)
- Clubhouse access may be limited or restricted at events at the discretion of the host course. Some facilities may have some portion of the clubhouse accessible for to-go food and beverage or for limited restroom access

Playing on the Golf Course:

- Players will be instructed by the starter to maintain social distancing during play. Players will also be instructed to leave the flagstick in the hole and avoid picking up other players' equipment around the green.
- Devices will be installed in the holes to aid players in contactless pickup of their golf ball.
- Although TSPGA Junior staff won't mandate masks to be worn by players, it will be strongly recommended that masks be worn in places that social distancing may be limited or hard to maintain (on the starting tee, scoring area, etc.) On the course, players are free to choose whether or not to wear a mask.
- Where appropriate, TSPGA staff will still assist players on the course in rulings and ball searches while maintaining social distancing.

Scoring Area:

- Upon entering the scoring area, please be ready to confirm your scores
- Players be ready to confirm your scores verbally to each other
- Only players will be permitted in the scoring area and will be spaced out 6 feet
- If a ruling is needed, there will be a designated area for the ruling and only involve the players who were involved.
- After your scores are confirmed, please collect your golf bag and your belongings and you will be asked to leave the property.
- Playoff's will not occur. In the event of ties, players will split points and split golf shop credit

Awards:

- The Awards presentation will be online at the conclusion of the event.
 - All winners will have their plaques and coupons mailed to them

Spectator Policy:

- Spectators will be limited to 2 spectators per parent
- Spectator carts will not be available
- Spectators will be strongly encouraged to wear masks while on property.

Inclement Weather Policy:

- In the event of dangerous weather, Tri-State PGA Junior Staff will be extending the alert range to 20 miles.
- Should play be suspended, the staff will sound the alert system and players will evacuate from the golf course. Players will be directed to the appropriate rooms, and updates will be given in a timely manner.
