

## **Tri-State PGA Announces Three New Inductees into Hall of Fame**

**Moon Township Pennsylvania (October 20, 2020):** The Officers, Board of Directors, and Past Presidents of the Tri-State PGA Section are happy to announce that John Aber, PGA Barry Evans, PGA, and Terry George, PGA have been inducted into the Tri-State PGA Hall of Fame. These three men have exemplified professionalism, mentorship, and strong playing resumes, making them perfect additions to the TSPGA Hall of Fame!

### **John Aber, PGA (Allegheny Country Club)**

The Head Professional at Allegheny Country Club since 2000, John has been an active member of the Tri-State PGA, serving in various roles from Board Member to President of the Section. John is a 2010 recipient of the Section's Golf Professional of the Year and a winner of the Bill Strausbaugh Award for mentoring. On the golf course, John has had great success winning many of the Section's top tournaments as well as Chuck Scally Sr. Player of the Year, and the Willie McKay Low Scoring Average multiple times.

### **Barry Evans, PGA (Berry Hills Country Club)**

The Head Professional at Berry Hills Country Club (Charleston WV) since 1991 Barry, has enjoyed a remarkable career as a PGA Professional. Barry became a PGA Member in 1995 and has been an active member of the TSPGA ever since. Barry served the Section as President of the West Virginia Chapter for eight years and served on The TSPGA Board of Directors as the West Virginia Representative. In 2011 Barry received the Patriot Award for his work with veterans of West Virginia. Barry received the distinguished West Virginian Award in 2002, The highest honor that can be presented to a West Virginian. Barry's playing resume includes championships throughout the State and the Section, including the 2002 National Club Professional Championship. Barry is a member of the West Virginia Golf Hall of Fame and a 25-year member of the PGA of America.

### **Terry George, PGA ( Pro Emretius Lone Pine Country Club)**

A quarter-century member of the PGA of America, Terry has been an active member of the Section. Terry was elected to membership in 1970 and spent time at facilities in the TSPGA. In 1975 Terry became the Head Golf Professional at Lone Pine Country Club. During Terry's time, he became an active member of the Section serving on the TSPGA Board of Directors from 1977-1983, serving as the Tournament Director. In 1983 Terry was recognized as the TSPGA Golf Professional of the Year. Terry's playing resume includes several top-ten finishes and a win in the 1980 TSPGA Match Play Championship. Terry has served our country in the United States Air Force and is currently the mayor of Green Hills Borough in Washington County.

These men will be recognized at the annual fall meeting of the Tri-State PGA on Monday, October 26th, 2020, at Valley Brook Country Club.
