


#### **TOTTERIDGE**









## 27 HOLE PRO/PRO CHAMPIONSHIP

## A NOTE FROM GREG STENZEL

It's the start of the new fiscal year for the PGA and with that, I need to ask you all to complete or update your Compensation Survey. - CLICK HERE or paste this link in your browser - https://account.pga.org/compensation-profile

If you completed your survey last year, all the information is saved. Simply login, change any comp numbers which changed and CLICK SUBMIT! If nothing changed, CLICK SUBMIT. Your information will be saved and you will receive an MSR for your participation. If you didn't complete a survey last year, the process takes less than 3 minutes.

It's important for both the Section and for me. The Section can qualify for additional PGA Funding when the Section reaches the targeted percentage. Tri-State members accomplished that last year and I know we can do it again.

It helps me help you. I can use the information to better inform employers on the current comp requirements for positions and I can assist you with comp comparisons when you are negotiating new agreements.

I will keep David informed on our progress. We currently have 63 members who have completed or updated their compensation survey since January 1, 2022. That means we have 180 members who need to update or complete their comp surveys.

Please make this a priority and find a couple minutes in your schedule to complete or update your comp survey. I appreciate it.
