I have been the Head Golf Professional at Rolling Fields Golf Club for 10 years. Prior to Rolling Fields, I worked as a golf pro at Dicks Sporting Goods for 15 years, Head Golf Professional at New Castle Country Club for 3 years and assistant pro at Dayton Country Club for 4 years.
