I have been the Head Golf Professional at Edgewood Country Club for 18 years. Prior to my tenure at Edgewood, I worked as an Assistant Professional at Baltusrol Golf Club and Plainfield Country Club in New Jersey, Blue Ridge Country Club in Harrisburg, and The Loxahatchee Club in Jupiter, FL.

I was basically raised in the golf industry. My father and uncle are both PGA Master Professionals. My cousin is the CEO of one of the largest golf management companies in the country. My Great-grandfather was a member of the Golf Course Superintendent Association. After playing college golf at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, I knew becoming a PGA Professional was the next step in my life.
