PGA LEAD has been active for 10 years and developed 129 individuals, 44 of them serving on a national or section committee or board. In our continuous journey to improve, Kyle Helms and Erin Sargent have implemented some enhancements based on feedback from previous PGA LEAD cohorts.

The program has been streamlined to a 12-month duration, previously set at 18 months (but will include all of the same key components).

We will now launch the program each August and conclude the following August (Cohort 10 will span from August 2025 to August 2026).
